Theoretical Examinations -> Web- Based Examinations

Please carefully read the following items before entering a web- based exam.


Before the Exam

1. Log in the system through a trusted and updated device which has an uninterrupted Internet connection.
2. You do not need a fast Internet connection.
3. You may take the exam on a computer, a tablet or mobile phone. However, we strongly recommend you choose a large screened computer in order not to face problems associated with a narrow screen.
4. A mouse is needed to select the questions while taking the exam on a computer. Of course, you may use the "touchpad" of a laptop computer.
5. The exam will be administered through a web browser. For this purpose, we recommend you use the latest updated version of Google Chrome web browser.
6. Please log in through <https://medu.yiu.edu.tr> using your regular **Medu username and password**.
7. You may access the web-based exams by following **Sınavlar > Kuramsal Sınavlar (Exams > Theoretical Exams)** on the main menu.
8. You may view all web-based exams that are assigned in a week on the top of the screen. A button captioned **Sınavı Başla (Start the Exam)** is displayed next to those web-based exams corresponding to your current date and time.
9. If you access this window before the date and time of the exam, **Sınavı Başlama (Start the Exam)** button will be shown only when the time/date assigned to such exam has come. If the "Start the Exam" button is not displayed despite the start time of the exam, please refresh the page (or press F5 on your keyboard). Thus "**Start The Exam**" button will be displayed for the exam the time.
10. The web-based exams which do not involve you, may also be displayed on this screen too. When you attempt to take those exams, the system will not let you in.
11. Exam timer starts at the exact exam time that is stated. That is why you must access to your exam before not too much time passes before starting time. If you attend the exam late, the time you have lost will not be compensated for the late user. For instance, you may remain on the exam screen only for 40 minutes in an exam, for which 60 minutes of time is given, which you started doing at the 20th minutes late.
12. You do not need to log in into the system a few hours beforehand and wait for the exam to start. It is sufficient for you to be ready a few minutes before the exam.

13. If the web-based exams that can be accessed from outside of the institution is accessed from a different time zone, the examinee needs to take into consideration that the exam will be held in Turkish (Türkiye) local time.
14. The order of the exam questions will be different for each examinee.

Start the Exam

At the exams section, you will see a screen like shown below. Multiple web-based exams may be displayed on that screen. You may click on **Sınavı Başla (Start the Exam)** button next to the exam assigned to you and take it. The number of questions and number of times a question is displayed will also be shown on the screen. When you attempt to access an exam which is not assigned to you, the system will not let you take that exam.

On the left part of the screen, there is information about you and exam time, markings for returning to a question, buttons for scrolling through the questions as well as the exam finishing button.

1. You must pay attention to the exam time span. You may finish and log out before expiry of the exam time span. The exam duration counts down.
2. The time/duration shown on the screen is not for a single question but for the entire exam.
3. You must pay attention to the number of times a question is displayed. You may view/display each question of the exam you are taking, only for the number of times specified on the page. You may not review/redisplay and answer those questions which you pass without answering and for which you exceeded number of times for displaying.
4. You may place a star on a question which you do not want to give an answer at that time, and you want to answer it later. Those starred questions will be displayed on the answering chart. This feature might be used when the number of times for displaying a question is more than one. You may not place a star on a question which you have already answered.
5. You may scroll between next or previous questions by clicking on the direction/scrolling buttons.
6. You may finish the exam by clicking on the **Sınavı Bitir (Finish the Exam)** button at the end of the exam. When exam time/duration expires and your exam screen is still open and your exam is still unfinished, the system will terminate/finish the exam on behalf of you. All your markings will be saved.

In the middle section of the screen, the questions that you will answer are displayed.

1. Each question comes to screen as marked **Blank**.
2. You may choose any answer by clicking on the options by means of a mouse.
3. You may mark a question, which you have already answered, as **Blank** if you wish.
4. You may change the answer given to a question as many times as you wish while you are displaying the question you are currently answering. Provided that you do not exceed number of times for displaying a question, you may navigate between the questions, as many times as you wish. You may not view/display and answer a question for which you exceeded number of times for displaying.
5. If there is a visual/image/illustration in a question, you may display such visual on a larger screen by clicking on it.
6. It is useful to mark the exam questions and your answers to them on a paper which you have in case of any negative / unwanted situation which might be caused by the device you are using to take the exam or the Internet connection.
7. In case you access an exam but waited until its end without doing your markings, the system might identify you as a threat and take you out of the exam. In order not to encounter such a situation, you are supposed to mark the answers one by one as you move forward, not in a single attempt to mark them all at the end.

On the right side of the screen, question numbers and whether you answered them or not are displayed.

1. The questions you answered will be displayed in dark green.
2. The questions you marked with a star to return later, will be displayed in yellow. This feature can be used when the number of times for displaying a question is more than one.
3. On this chart, you may see how many questions you answered and how many you left blank.
4. You may access any question you desire by clicking on the question number here.

Important notes you should know about the exam;

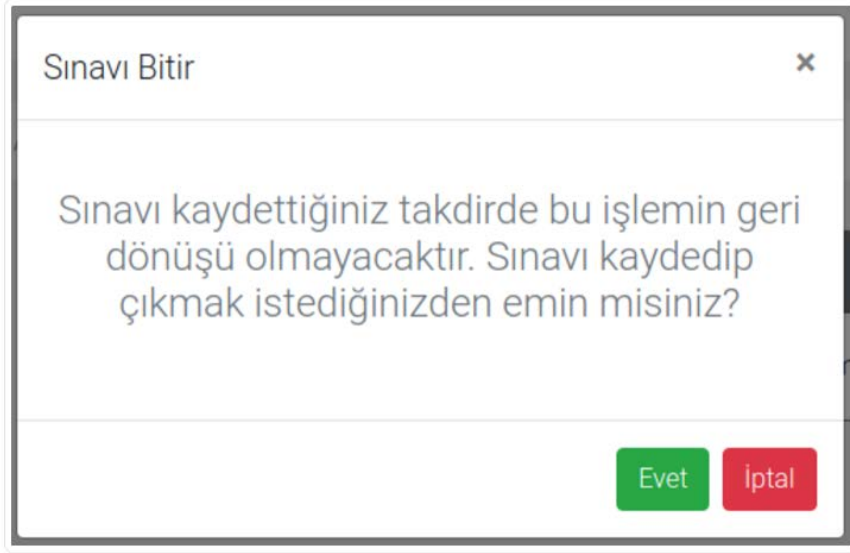
1. If you accidentally / mistakenly log out and end your session by clicking on the **Çıkış (Logout)** button on the main menu during the exam, you may re-login and access the exam screen and continue your exam from where you left.
2. If you accidentally / mistakenly close the web browser, later you may launch the web browser again, to access the exam screen and continue your exam from where you left.
3. If your Internet connection is cut / severed, you may re-login into your account from another device using 4.5G Internet connection (Data) and continue your exam from where you left.
4. You may encounter a warning like "Your answer could not be saved due to a momentary network problem. Please choose again." when you click on the answer to a question. This

warning means that your Internet connection is disrupted and the answer you gave couldn't reach the system. This is not caused by MEDU but your Internet connection being lost momentarily or for a short period of time. In such a case, wait for a few seconds and remark on the answer of the question. Your answer will be saved if there is no problem with your Internet connection. If your Internet connection could not be restored while waiting, you may access the exam again from another Internet network and continue your exam from where you left. However, you may view and mark this question again because you viewed the last question you had problems with.

5. In order to avoid experiencing such problems, you must ensure that your Internet connection is not problematic throughout the duration of the exam.
6. If duration/time of the exam expires when you try to re-access the exam after leaving the exam screen due to a problem you experience, you may not access your exam screen and save your exam. You should notify this problem to the relevant unit of the faculty right after the exam ends. The administrators of the exam might save the final version of your exam and all the markings you made until the very moment that you experience the problem will be valid.

Finish the Exam

1. The answer you gave to each question will be saved. However, if you do not save your exam by clicking on **Sınavı Bitir (Finish the Exam)** button, you will be deemed as you did not take the exam.
2. The system will automatically save your exam at the expiry of the exam duration while you are on the exam screen.
3. When you click on **Sınavı Bitir (Finish the Exam)** button after making all your markings, you will save and finish the exam.
4. When you click on **Sınavı Bitir (Finish the Exam)** button, you will see a confirmation screen similar to one shown below. Make sure you click **Evet (Yes)** button. After that, a message stating that your exam is successfully saved will be shown.



Caution: You cannot take the exam again / re-access the exam after you have finished and approved the exam during the exam period.
